⁷ In order to matriculate in the upper division business curriculum, students must complete the DCOBA Admissions Application to be admitted. Additionally, students must complete all nine (27 semester hours) of the business core courses with an overall GPA on those courses of 2.2, and have completed an additional 21 hours in the university core.
